Water treatment plant:

- The City received notice from the state that our water system operator is not certified in North Dakota. Auditor Fett had reached out to Greg Stang Regional manager at PeopleService in regard to this and has not received any response. Attorney Turman to reach out to the state to find out what needs to be done to get him certified. Motion by Campbell, second by Althoff, to withhold all payments to PeopleService due to this infraction. Motion carried.

Motion by Campbell, second by Schulz, to approve bills. Motion carried. Motion by Triebold, second by Campbell, to approve financials. Motion carried.

Snow removal equipment update – equipment to be winterized. Speed bumps have been removed. Residents will need to start staking their yards, especially by the sprinklers, to help the snow removal crew know where their lot lines are. The snow removal crew will be marking areas where the snow will be pushed as well as marking the drains. The tool cat is currently in for service. The Ram needs to go in for service.
